



QRA SEQ Rogainer of the Year Series Points System

The following events are included in the QRA SEQ Calendar for 2017:

1. These events will form the 2017 QRA SEQ Rogainer of the Year series and competitors in all these events will receive points based on their placing in the event
2. Points are awarded to individuals not teams. Every member of a team in a particular event receives the same number of points
3. A competitor's points from their best 50 hours shall be their final points score for the year
4. Competitors in the winning team of any event shall receive a *raw score* of 100 points times the nominal duration of the event in hours (ie the winners of a 24-hour event will receive a *raw score* of 2,400 points for that event)
5. All other competitors in that event shall receive a *raw score* based on their percentage of the winning score rounded to the nearest whole number. Thus if a team in 24-hour event get exactly 50% of the winning score they will receive a *raw score* of 1,200 points for that event
6. Where a shorter duration event is conducted concurrently points will be awarded for that shorter event as a separate event. Thus the winners of the MOJO Raid 6-Hr for example will receive a *raw score* of 600 points
7. The *raw scores* will be adjusted by normalising to a mean score for all teams in the event of 50 points/hour. This will smooth out anomalies, particularly for events where there is a very large gap between the top team(s) and the rest of the field

8. For each event a record will be kept of the following for each competitor:
 - a. Event duration
 - b. Raw points scored
 - c. Raw points per hour
 - d. Adjusted points scored
 - e. Adjusted points per hour – To simplify identifying the competitor's best 50 hours
9. As it is unlikely that most competitors will have their best 50 hours in events that exactly total 50 hours the points for one event will be prorated as necessary to get the required best 50 hours score
10. Any QRA member who is prevented from competing in an event because of volunteer tasks they undertook for that event will be eligible for series points with a score of the maximum duration of the event they volunteered for times the points per hour for their best competition event during the series. The maximum number of scoring volunteer hours shall not exceed 24 in the series
